### **FareShare**

FareShare is the UK's longest running food redistribution charity. They were born out of the belief that no good food should go to waste, especially when people are going hungry. The organisation was established in 1994 by the homeless charity Crisis in collaboration with Sainsbury's. 2019 marked FareShare's 25-year anniversary of fighting hunger and food waste. The biggest charitable operation of its kind in the UK, in the 25 years since its launch, FareShare has provided food equivalent to 236.8 million meals – all provided to people in need via our network of frontline charities, and worth £179.9 million in costs avoided by the voluntary sector if they bought the same food and drink.



Sedbury Space are pleased to be able to help with this food redistribution in Sedbury and Beachley, especially with the additional difficulties families are facing during the Covid-19 pandemic. # **Census** 2021

#### "Ready, steady, census"

The decennial census is almost upon us.

Households across **Sedbury** will soon be asked to take part in the nationwide survey of housing and the population. It has been carried out every decade since 1801, with the exception of 1941.

Information from the digital-first census will help decide how services are planned and funded in your local area. This could mean things like doctors' surgeries, housing or new bus routes.

Households will receive a letter with a unique access code in the post, allowing them to complete their questionnaire online. Paper questionnaires will be available on request.

### Food Hamper distribution

Susan, our Centre Manager was busy last week involved in a project organized by FVAF, distributing 100 hampers to Secondary schools across the Forest of Dean. This was a collaboration with the Local Equality Commission, Sixteen Community Café, FareShare and The Forest Foodbank creating hampers with essential cupboard goods, recipe cards and stationery.

Foodbanks have reported a massive 61% increase in demand with tens of thousands of people using food banks for the first time.
